



Aranayak Fuel and Power Set to Break Ground on Country's First Biomass-Based Green Hydrogen Plant

On March 3, Aranayak Fuel and Power will break ground on its Rs 50-crore, 1 tonne-per-day, biomass-based green hydrogen plant in Mirzapur district of Uttar Pradesh. The company had signed an MoU with the state government during the recently held 'global investors' meet' in Uttar Pradesh. The plant, which aims to begin production of green hydrogen on August 15, will be India's first commercial-scale biomass-based green hydrogen project.
